ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In tribal or state foster care on or after 16th birthday.

Adoption from foster care finalized after 16th birthday, or exited care to guardianship or reunification after 16th birthday.

U.S. citizen or qualified non-citizen.

ETV recipients must be making satisfactory progress in school to remain eligible for continued funding until 26th birthday.

The maximum number of years a student can receive ETV funding is five (5) years, consecutive or intermittent.

Accepted into or enrolled in a degree, certificate or other accredited program at a college, university, technical or vocational school.

Arizona ETV is a program of the Arizona Department of Child Safety and is administered by Foster Care to Success.
