Hot Conditions Continue This Week

- High temperatures ranging between 105-110°F through Thursday
- Hotter temperatures on Friday (upper 100s to low 110s across lower deserts)
- Widespread **Moderate HeatRisk**

Tuesday-Wednesday: Breezy to Windy Conditions

- Widespread afternoon/evening gusts 25-35 mph, locally higher across higher terrain of southcentral AZ
- Fire Weather: **Red Flag Warning** in effect for Tuesday and a **Fire Weather Watch** for Wednesday across the south-central AZ higher terrain due to hot, dry, and windy conditions

This Weekend into the 4th of July: Major HeatRisk

- 20-40% chance of reaching 115°F across the Phoenix metro and southeastern California as early as Saturday
- Dangerous heat impacts persisting through the 4th of July

Main weather story for this week continues to be the hot temperatures as well as the enhanced breeziness and critical fire weather expected through Wednesday. There is potential to see dangerous heat this weekend with highs approaching 115 degrees across the lower deserts.

Southwest Arizona (La Paz & Yuma Counties)



Heat

Impacts:

• Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily

• Moderate HeatRisk through Saturday with temperatures ranging from 100-110°F for highs (30-60% chance of exceeding 110°F on Friday) and 65-75°F for lows

Southeast California (Imperial and Eastern Riverside Counties)



Heat

Impacts:

• Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

• Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Moderate: Daily through Friday; Major: Saturday

• Moderate HeatRisk through Friday with temperatures ranging from 100-110°F for highs and 70-75°F for lows

• Major HeatRisk developing as early as Saturday, as high temperatures reach above 110°F (10-30% chance of exceeding 115°F) and overnight temperatures rise between 75-80°F
