Attention Community Members

The Animal Control Department would like to remind all animal owners who live on the Quechan Indian Reservation that they are to comply with the Animal Control Ordinance.

The Quechan Count team is currently assisting with escorting Census Takers around Fort Yuma Reservation. Door to Door Enumeration will begin Monday, September 14, 2020 thru Friday, September 18, 2020 all day. The Animal Control Department would like the communities cooperation with ensuring a safe environment during their Door to Door Enumeration around the Fort Yuma Reservation.

Here a few quick tips to help keep in compliance as responsible animal owners.

Dogs at large:

All dogs must be contained within the owner's property. This can be done in many ways, most common is by **fence, chain/rope or tether, a dog run, a cage/kennel, or keeping dogs indoors at all times.**

Non-compliance can result in Fines:

- Dog at large: \$50.00
- Leashes/Not contained to property: \$25.00
- Vicious dogs: \$250.00

Dog bites:

In an event of a dog bite, all unvaccinated and vaccinated dogs that have committed a bite will be required to be quarantined for no less than 10 days at our holding facility. This is to ensure that the dog does not have rabies. A dog that has bitten someone can be returned to owner after the 10 day quarantine with proof of rabies vaccination and registration.

Dog related Bite Fines:

- Dog Bite: \$150
- Quarantine: \$25 per day at our holding facility
- License/Registration: \$25
- Rabies vaccination: \$75
