

# Excessive Heat Warning in Effect Through Friday for South-central AZ | Hotter Next Week

### **KEY POINTS**

- Very hot temperatures persisting through the rest of the week with local areas of Major HeatRisk mainly in the Phoenix Metro through Friday.
- Hotter temperatures likely for next week with a return of widespread Major HeatRisk expected by around Monday.
- High terrain thunderstorms possible by early next week.

## **CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING**

Excessive Heat Warning cancelled for southeast CA and southwest AZ. Slightly cooler temperatures through the weekend than originally forecast.

#### Higher Terrain South Central Arizona (Southern Gila County & Tonto NF Foothills in Maricopa County)


