Chance for Strong to Possibly Severe Storms Today | Drier and Turning Hotter by Late Week

KEY POINTS

- Good chance of storms today resulting in a Moderate risk of severe weather across southern and central Arizona
- Lingering isolated storm chances areawide on Tuesday
- Near to slightly above normal temperatures through mid-week. Potential return of very localized areas of Major HeatRisk by the weekend.

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence. The weather hazard with the greatest risk will be listed first in the matrix.

Higher Terrain South Central Arizona (Southern Gila County & Tonto NF Foothills in Maricopa County)



Impacts:

Strong gusty winds, small hail, and heavy rainfall

Timing:

Daily Through Wednesday

- Scattered to numerous afternoon thunderstorms (60-80% chance) today and Tuesday
- Probability of gusty thunderstorm winds in excess of 35 mph is 70% today and only 10-30% Tuesday
- Moderate Risk of strong to severe storms today
- Reduced storm chances Wednesday (20-30% chance) with virtually no chance starting Thursday



Impacts:

• Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing

Minor to Moderate HeatRisk

Southwest Arizona (La Paz & Yuma Counties)



Impacts:

Strong gusty winds, areas of dense blowing dust, small hail, and heavy rainfall

Timing:

Moderate Risk Today (La Paz Co.) - Minor Risk Tuesday

- Thunderstorm chances 40-70% this evening with a Moderate Risk of strong to severe storms mainly in La Paz Co.
- 20-30% chance of thunderstorms Tuesday



Impacts:

• Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Southeast California (Imperial and Eastern Riverside Counties)



Impacts:

Strong gusty winds, dense blowing dust, small hail, and heavy rainfall

Timing:

Minor Risk Today - Moderate Risk Tuesday

- Thunderstorm chances 20-40% today
- 30-50% chance of thunderstorms Tuesday with a Moderate Risk of strong to severe storms mainly over Imperial Co.



Impacts:

• Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:


