

Above Normal Temperatures and Overall Dry Conditions Into Next Week

KEY POINTS

- Above normal temperatures into next week with today seeing the highest temperatures with lower desert highs of 100-104 degrees.
- Breezy conditions Friday night and Saturday morning across eastern and south-central Arizona
- Low rain chances (5-15%) across eastern high terrain areas this weekend


