



Turning Cooler into the Weekend | Locally Windy Friday

KEY POINTS

- Well above normal temperatures today with lower desert highs in the upper 70s to lower 80s. Cooling trend Thursday into the weekend with temperatures back to around normal for Saturday and Sunday.
- Breezy to locally windy Friday, especially across the Lower CO River Valley.
- Dry weather to persist well into next week.

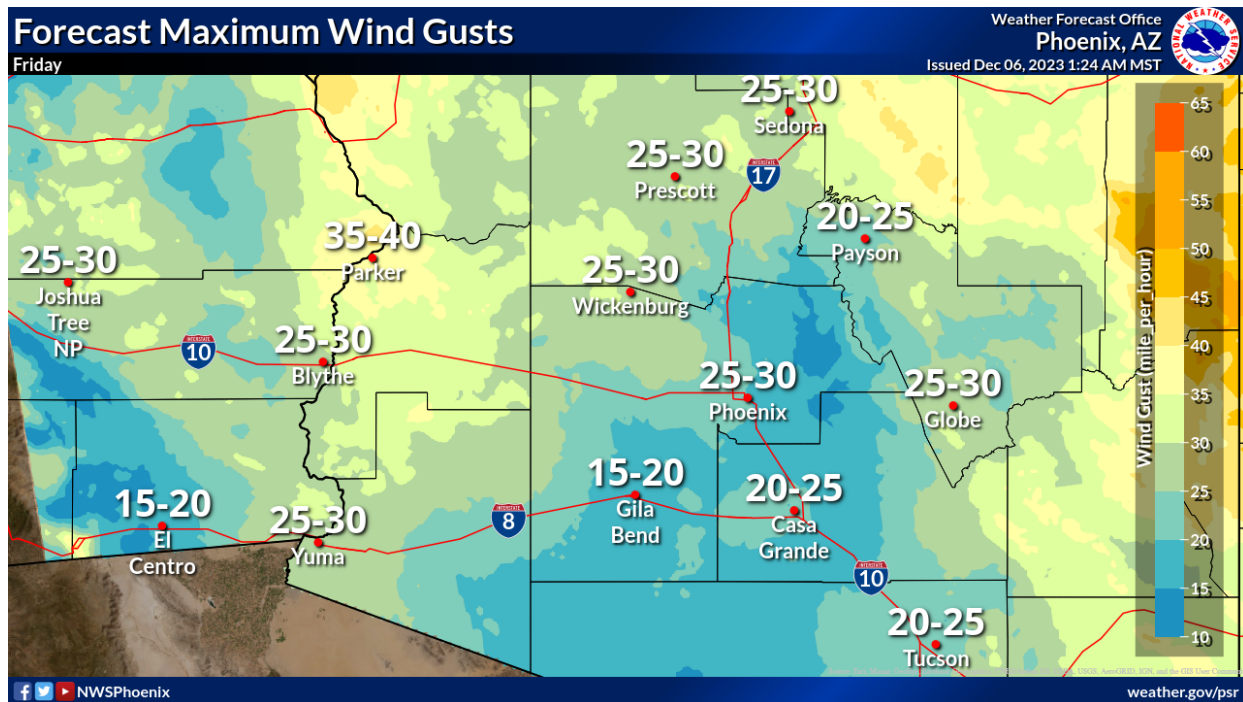

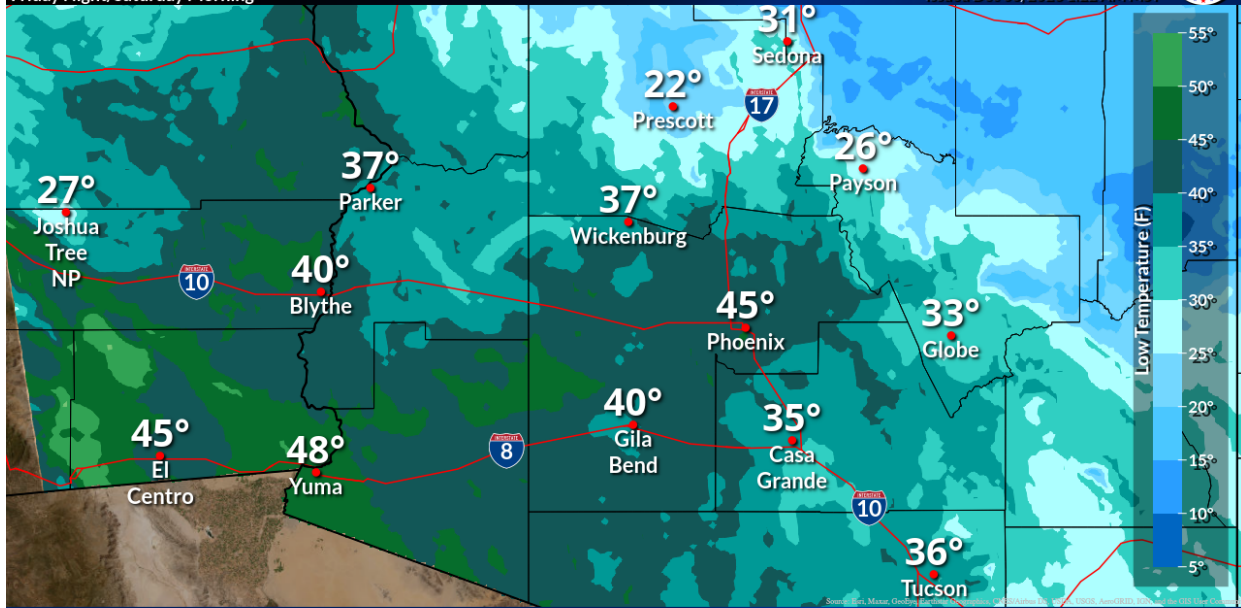
