



## Cooler with Showers/Isolated Thunderstorms Today | Above Normal Temperatures Return Sunday

### KEY POINTS

- **Chance of showers this morning. Showers and isolated thunderstorms likely in the afternoon, mainly across central Arizona.**
- **Rain amounts generally up to a tenth of an inch across the lower deserts, but with localized higher amounts. Up to a quarter of an inch possible across the higher terrain north and east of Phoenix.**
- **Warming trend beginning Friday, with minor HeatRisk developing across the region Sunday.**

### WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence. The weather hazard with the greatest risk will be listed first in the matrix.

## South-Central Arizona including the Phoenix Area



Heat

**Impacts:**

Low Risk for heat-related illnesses for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

**Timing:**

Sunday-Wednesday (Lower Deserts)

- High temperatures reaching the lower 80s by Sunday across the Phoenix Area.



Thunderstorms

**Impacts:**

Isolated thunderstorms

**Timing:**

Late Morning through the Afternoon

Any thunderstorms that develop will be capable of producing brief heavy rain, wind gusts to 30 mph and small hail.

## Southeast California



Heat

**Impacts:**

Low Risk for heat-related illnesses for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

**Timing:**

Saturday-Wednesday

- High temperatures reaching the lower 80s by Sunday.

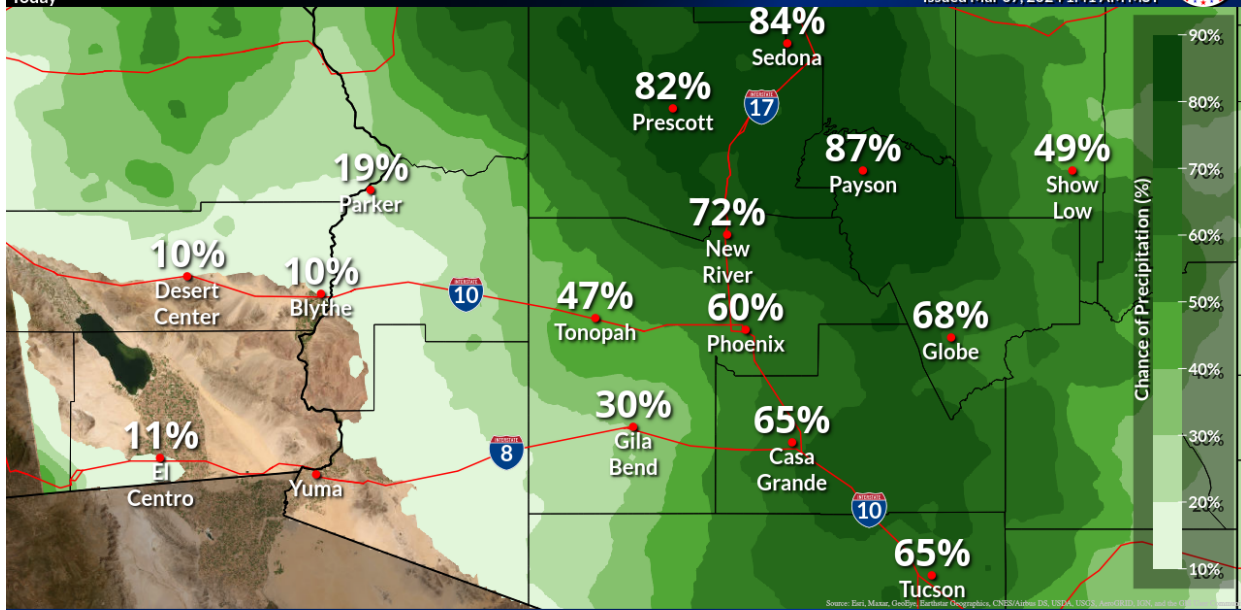
