# Lingering High Terrain Rain Early this Week | Dry and Warm Latter Half of the Week

# **KEY POINTS**

- Chance of showers and isolated weak thunderstorms today and Tuesday over higher terrain north and east of Phoenix.
- Dry and near to slightly above normal temperatures Wednesday Saturday
- Potential strong weather system around next Sunday Tuesday. Uncertainty remains with the timing and exact details of potential impacts.

Sunday

• Potential for gusty winds of greater than 30 mph next weekend, most likely on Sunday
