



## Excessive Heat Warning for Phoenix Today | Strong T-Storm Winds Possible Today across South-Central AZ

### KEY POINTS

- Excessive Heat Warning for south-central AZ with localized Major HeatRisk today for the Phoenix metro. Hot and humid conditions will continue through this weekend.
- Thunderstorm chances this afternoon and early evening focused across eastern half of Pinal Co., far eastern Maricopa County, and into southern Gila County. Strong winds and blowing dust are the main threats today over Phoenix and areas east and southeast of Phoenix. Daily chances of isolated lower desert storms and scattered higher terrain storms increasing over the weekend.
- Very hot temperatures with near Major HeatRisk are expected this weekend, with areas of Major HeatRisk developing by early next week.

### WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

## Phoenix Metropolitan



Heat

### Impacts:

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

### Timing:

Major HeatRisk Today and likely early next week

### Details:

#### • Excessive Heat Warning Today

- Areas of Major HeatRisk today, with highs 110-114°F
- Widespread Moderate HeatRisk over the weekend, as high temperatures cool into the 105-110°F range
- Areas of Major HeatRisk developing once again early next week, as high temperatures climb back into the 109-115°F range and lows 85-93°F



Strong Wind

### Impacts:

Strong Thunderstorm Outflow Winds and Areas of Blowing Dust

### Timing:

Friday-Sunday

### Confidence:

Today: Medium; Weekend: Low

### Details:

- Today: West Phoenix: 20-40% probability of 35+ mph winds  
East Phoenix and much of Pinal County: 30-70% probability of 35+ mph winds
- Any strong outflow winds could lead to localized reductions in visibility due to blowing dust, especially across Pinal Co.
- Saturday - 30-50% probability of 35+ mph wind gusts



Thunderstorms

### Impacts:

Lightning, localized strong winds, brief heavy rainfall

### Timing:

Today-Monday

### Details:

- Today: 5-15% chance of thunderstorms across the Phoenix metro, 25-40% in higher terrain of Pinal and far eastern Maricopa counties
- Increasing chances over the weekend between 20-40% (highest in higher terrain), generally 10% chance Monday
- Best chance of any localized heavier rainfall should be Saturday and Sunday

## Higher Terrain SC AZ



Heat

### Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

### Timing:

Daily

### Details:

- Moderate HeatRisk continuing into next week, as highs range from 96-104°F



Thunderstorms

### Impacts:

Gusty winds, lightning, and localized heavy rainfall

### Timing:

Moderate Today; Minor Starting Saturday

### Details:

- 20-30% chance of thunderstorms Today.
- Today: 50-70% probability of 35+ mph winds - 10% probability of 58+ mph winds
- 20-40% chance of thunderstorms Friday-Sunday, lowering early next week



Wind

### Impacts:

Strong winds may produce difficult driving conditions for high profile vehicles. Loose or unsecured objects may be blown away.

### Timing:

This Morning

### Details:

- **Wind Advisory continuing Today until 11 am for southern Gila County, including San Carlos and Globe**
- Wind gusts of 30-40 mph at times.

## Southwest Arizona



Heat

### Impacts:

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

### Timing:

Moderate HeatRisk Today-Sunday; Major HeatRisk possible as early as Monday

### Details:

- Widespread Moderate HeatRisk with highs 109-113° today
- Highs 105-110° Saturday and Sunday, but with increased humidity as lows warm into the low to mid-80s
- Even hotter early next week with highs 110-114° by Tuesday. Areas of Major HeatRisk as early as Monday.



Thunderstorms

### Impacts:

Gusty winds, lightning, and brief heavy downpours

### Timing:

Saturday and Sunday

### Details:

- 10-30% chance of thunderstorms

## Southeast California



### Impacts:

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

### Timing:

Overall Moderate HeatRisk through Sunday; Major HeatRisk Monday - Thursday

### Details:

- Widespread Moderate HeatRisk with highs 110-114° today
- Highs 105-110° Saturday and Sunday, but with increased humidity, with overnight lows warming into the low to mid-80s by Sunday
- Even hotter early next week as areas of Major HeatRisk develop, with highs 111-116° by Tuesday.

## Joshua National Park



### Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

### Timing:

Moderate HeatRisk

### Details:

- Widespread Moderate HeatRisk as highs climb to 99-108° starting today
- Localized Major HeatRisk potentially developing early next week as even hotter conditions develop with highs 102-111° by Tuesday.



### Timing

- Through 11 AM MST Friday, June 21st


### Forecast

- Southwest winds 25-30 mph
- Gusts up to 45 mph

### Precautions

- ✓ Difficult driving conditions - especially high profile vehicles 
- ✓ Loose items may become airborne

# Isolated to Scattered Showers & Thunderstorms Possible

Friday, June 21st, 2024

## Details:

- Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will once again fire up along and east of a moisture gradient just east of the Phoenix Metro.
- Rain chances will increase to around 10-40% by this afternoon and evening, with the best chances in the higher terrain to the east of Phoenix.
- These storms will be capable of producing strong gusty outflow boundaries, which could lead to some areas of patchy blowing dust.

Gusty winds in excess of 30 mph from thunderstorm outflows possible



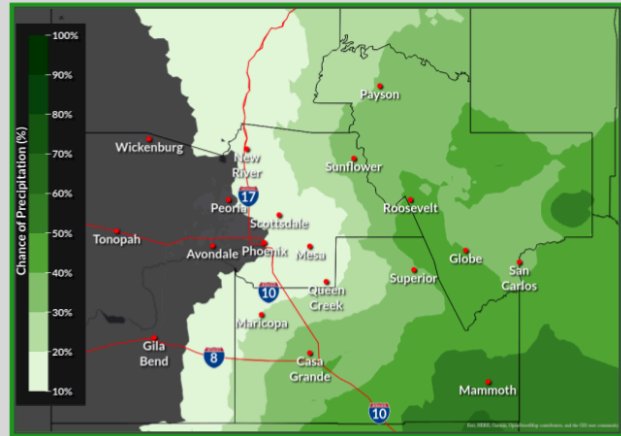
Occasional lightning
