



## Near to Above Normal Temperatures Cooling to Below Normal by the Weekend | Unsettled Weather Possible Late this Weekend

### KEY POINTS

- Temperatures will be near to above normal through Thursday, ahead of a more significant cooldown going into this weekend and persisting into next week.
- Minor Heat Risk on Thursday, with lower desert highs in the low to mid-80s.
- Rain potential across southcentral Arizona increases for late this weekend, but chances remain modest (25-35%), favoring higher terrain areas.

### WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

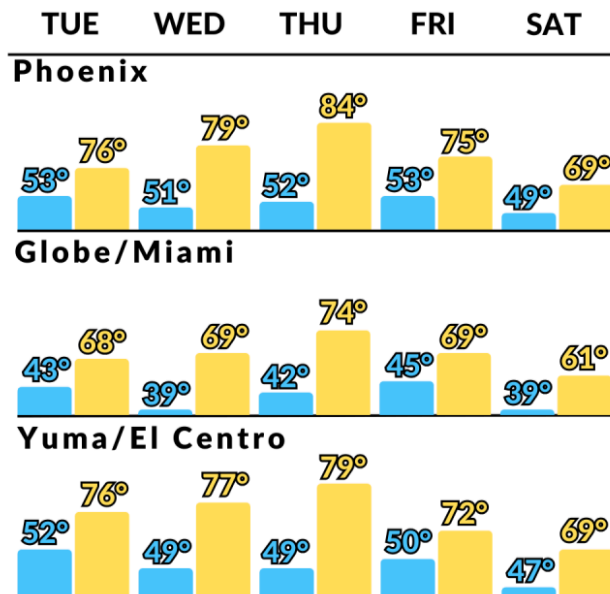
