

# Warming Trend Continues with Near Record Temperatures Thursday & Friday | Temperatures Start to Cool this Weekend

## **KEY POINTS**

- Warming trend will last through the end of the workweek, with 90s returning this afternoon across portions of SE CA and SW AZ.
- Moderate HeatRisk likely for Thursday and Friday with highs in the upper 90s to low 100s for the lower deserts.
- Cooling trend this weekend into the first part of next week as dry conditions persist.

## WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.
