

Seasonably Cool Temperatures and Daily Breeziness Early This Week | Warming Temperatures Into Late Week

KEY POINTS

- Below normal temperatures will continue through early this week. Expect daily afternoon breeziness to continue during this period as well before subsiding during the middle portions of the week.
- Temperatures warming with widespread Minor HeatRisk returning early this week and persisting into this upcoming weekend.

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.
