



Extreme Heat Warning Today | Above Normal Temperatures and Dry Rest of the Week

KEY POINTS

- Extreme Heat Warning in effect today with high temperatures 109-114°.
- Continued hot with widespread Moderate HeatRisk through at least Friday. Areas of Major HeatRisk likely for south-central AZ on Thursday.
- Dry conditions will last all week.

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

Increased HeatRisk today to Major for SE CA, SW AZ, and SC AZ Higher Terrain

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Today and Thursday, otherwise Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- **Extreme Heat Warning in effect Today**
- Highs 109-113°F today.
- Highs 107-111°F Tuesday and Wednesday to as high as 110-115°F on Thursday.
- Temperatures likely cooling to near normal by next Sunday.

Higher Terrain SC AZ



Heat

Impacts:

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Today and Thursday, otherwise Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- **Extreme Heat Warning in effect Today**
- Areas of Major HeatRisk Today with highs as hot 110°F.
- Moderate HeatRisk most other days with highs mainly between 95-105°F.
- Localized Major HeatRisk on Thursday with highs between 98-108°F.
- Temperatures likely cooling to near normal by next Sunday.

Southwest Arizona

Major Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and much of the population, especially with extended outdoor exposure, and for those who are heat sensitive and/or without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Today, otherwise high-end Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- **Extreme Heat Warning in effect Today**
- Highs 109-113°F today.
- Highs 107-112°F Tuesday-Friday.
- Temperatures likely cooling to near normal by next Sunday.

Southeast CA

- Highs 107-112°F Tuesday-Friday.
- Temperatures likely cooling to near normal by next Sunday.

Joshua Tree NP



Heat

Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily

Details:

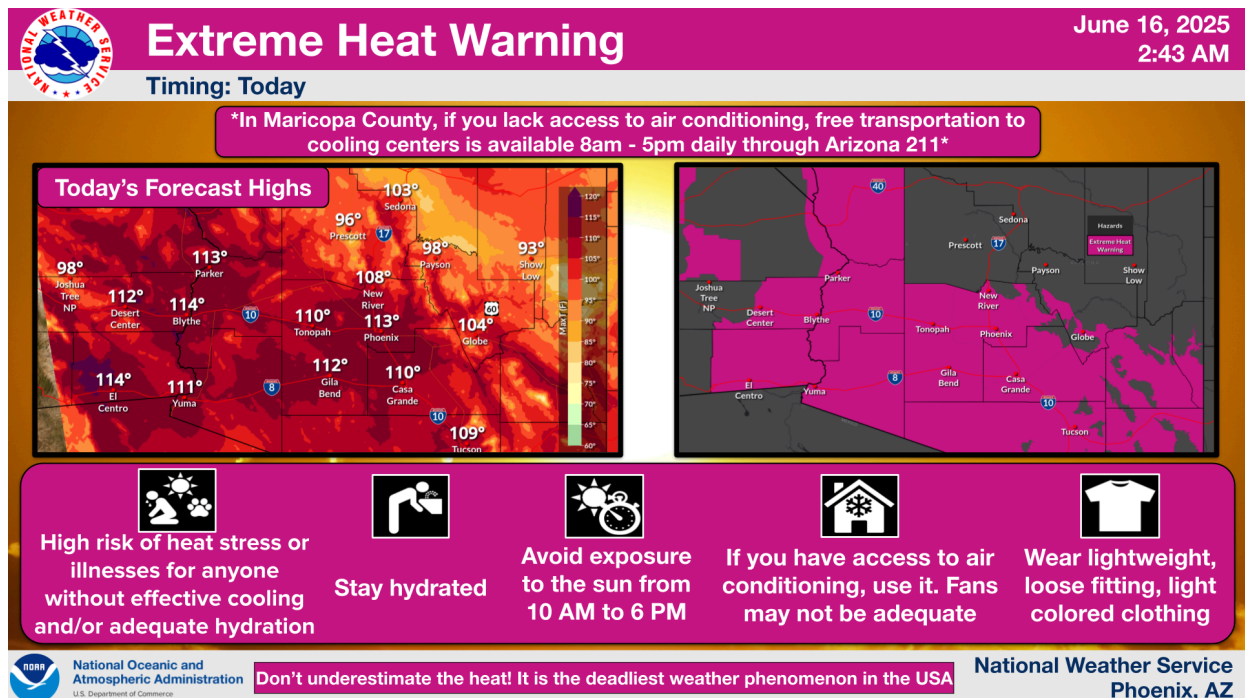
- Highs 105-110°F (east/lower elevations) to the mid to upper-90s (west/higher elevations) today.
- Highs 100-105°F (east/lower elevations) to the upper 80s to low 90s (west/higher elevations) starting Tuesday.
- Temperatures likely cooling to near normal by next Sunday.

High temperatures 5-10 degrees above normal this week



- Lower desert high temperatures hovering around 110-115°F through Friday, with morning lows in the mid-70s to mid-80s
- Temperatures will result in widespread Moderate HeatRisk, with areas of Major HeatRisk Today and Thursday
- Very dry conditions and mostly sunny skies will prevail through the next several days with a weak weather system passing through Tuesday - Wednesday that will temporarily lower temperatures a few degrees before heating up again and peaking Thursday
