2024/2025 Fall & Winter School Clothing Assistance Program

Open to Parents/Legal Guardians of Enrolled Quechan Tribal Members only (3–18 year olds).

The 2024/2025 Fall & Winter School Clothing Assistance Program has been developed to assist school age children (Headstart–12th Grade).

This assistance is to purchase items to prepare for the upcoming 2024/2025 School Year. You can purchase clothing, jackets, hats, school supplies, backpacks, shoes and haircuts.

The custodial parent must complete the application. If the applicant is not the custodial parent, documentation in the form of a Legal Custody Order or Guardianship Order through a court must accompany the application. All documents must be current. Notarized statements are **NOT** accepted.

Enrollment will be verified by the Revenue Distribution Office by a certified list provided by the Enrollment Department.

The child must be registered and verified by the School Registrar that they will be attending school. Eligible grades to participate.

1st through 12th. Grade - \$700.00
