DEER HUNTING REGULATIONS 2022

THE QUECHAN FISH AND GAME DEPARTMENT WILL BE OPENING UP A DEER HUNTING SEASON WITHIN CERTAIN SPECIFIED AREAS ON THE RESERVATION. THESE AREAS WILL INCLUDE:

- (1) All areas on the reservation, north of the All-American Canal, between Mission Wash and the potholes Mining Camp.
- (2) All areas north of the All- American Canel and WAPA Powerline between Mission Wash and the eastern reservation boundary.
- (3) The area between the All-American Canal and White rd, from Picacho Wash over to No-Name Wash.

The dates of the 2022 hunt will be: November 5 thru November 27.

All hunters must have a valid hunting permit **AND** valid deer tag.

* Hunting Permit: \$100.00 - Valid July 01 - June 30.

* Deer Tag: \$250.00

The shooting hours each day will be 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.

* NO NIGHT HUNTING AND NO SPOTLIGHTING!

Legal methods of take are: Bow and Rifle

* ALL AMMUNITION USED MUST BE NONLEAD PROJECTILES!

Deer eligible for take: FORKED-HORN BUCK

* A forked -horn buck is defined as a male deer having a branched antler on either side with the branch in the upper two-thirds of the antler. Eyeguards or other bony projection on the lower one-third of the antler **WILL NOT** be considered as points or branches.

All Declaration Forms and Tags will be filled out **BEFORE** leaving the hunting areas.

Deer tags **MUST** be signed before leaving the reservation.

Authorized agents and counter signers include:

- * Quechan Fish and Game Wardens and Secretary
- * Quechan Police Officers
- * California Fish and Wildlife Wardens
- * Imperial County Sheriff's Deputies

If a deer is taken, the bottom portion of your tag <u>MUST</u> be attached to the antler of your deer. All vehicles <u>MUST</u> stay within the washes. Driving over mesas could destroy precious native artifacts.
