Facility Maintenance Technician Duties & Responsibilities

- Maintain overall facility and associated facility equipment
- Areas of responsibility include all preventive and reactive equipment, building and site maintenance
- Use of a CMMS preventative maintenance system to perform work orders, manage spare part inventory, add new equipment or tasks as the need arises for all facility systems and equipment and maintain site equipment records/history
- Monitors and maintains a variety of monthly, quarterly, and yearly inspection logs such as emergency lighting, exit lighting, fire suppression system, fire alarm testing, building evacuation following standard procedure
- Performs monthly facility maintenance and safety audits
- Direct and participate in facility plumbing repairs
- Troubleshoots and performs minor electrical maintenance to include but not limited to replacement or repair of fixtures
- Responsible for the preventive maintenance of all site HVAC equipment by performing PM activities and contracting when needed
- Support and direct the work of facility and equipment contractors
- Basic building repairs including patching and painting walls, replacing ceiling tiles and other general maintenance and construction duties around the facility

- Works in a safe manner always, encourages a culture of zero harm, and is trained in arc flash, LOTO, basic electrical safety, ladder safety, and other plant programs to maintain a safe and healthy work environment
- Operates Heavy Equipment (examples manlift, forklift) as needed
- Repair and reassemble equipment using hand tools and power tools
- Implements corrective and preventive maintenance plans
- Participates in projects and upgrades
- Landscaping (trimming, sprinkler system) and general grounds keeping
- Operates and maintains a variety of maintenance associated power tools
- General overall cleaning, collects and disposes of all litter, trash, and debris in the building, on grounds and parking lots
- May be required to perform other facility maintenance duties and functions or assist in other departments as needed

Additional:

- Regular work schedule 10-hour work shift Monday - Thursday 6:00am - 4:30pm, occasional extended hours and weekends required based on business needs

Job Requirements:

- 7-10 years of experience safely performing facility operations and maintenance
- Bilingual preferred
- Desired skills: electrical, mechanical, plumbing, carpentry, HVAC operations, fabrication, pneumatics, hydraulics, motors, use and care of tools and equipment used in facility and ground maintenance
- Must be self-directed and have excellent troubleshooting capabilities to pinpoint problems and resolve issues in a timely manner
- Intermediate knowledge of computer software programs
- Able to read drawings, schematics, specifications and building plans and follow manual instructions
- The ability to lift, carry and position light (15 pounds consistently) to heavy objects (50 pounds occasionally) and push/pulling equipment of equal weight is required including the utilization of proper body mechanics and techniques
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, stoop, kneel crouch, climb, use ladders, and perform various types of manual labor
- Ability to use common hand tools and machines including floor scrubbers
- High school diploma, GED or state equivalent required; technical associate degree preferred
