POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position: Seasonal Lifeguard (4 openings)

Salary: \$15.00 Hourly
Non-exempt

Opening: Monday, June 13, 2022

Closing: Open Until Filled

This is a Seasonal (Part-Time) Position within the Parks & Recreation Department.

BASIC FUNCTION:

Incumbent will be under the direct supervision of the Parks and Recreation Director. This position will observe the activities of the pool patrons to prevent accidents and enforce swimming pool safety rules and regulations. This position is generally staffed from June through September annually.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Obtain and maintain lifeguard certification.
- Provides supervision/surveillance of all patrons in the pool area at all times.
- Reacts immediately to emergency situations and administers proper care.
- Provides emergency care and treatment until EMS arrive.
- Enforce pool rules and policies at all times.
- Presents a professional attitude and appearance at all times.
- Perform pool cleaning and maintenance duties including but not limited to regular cleaning of strainer baskets, vacuuming and skimming the pool, cleaning deck and grass areas, emptying trash receptacles, and overall cleanliness of the facility every day.
- Work well as a team with other lifeguards.
- Available to work varied shifts, including mornings, evenings, and weekends.
- Available to work summer special events.
- Assists in planning, developing and implementing recreational programs for the community.
- Will be responsible for emergency rescues in pool areas.
- Maintains schedule for pool hours.
- Communicate effectively with staff and public at all times.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be able to obtain a Level-1 Finger Print Clearance Card.
- Must be 15 years old and must be able to provide a Request for Work Permit Certificate of Age.

- Ability to react competently, calmly and effectively in all emergency situations.
- Ability to maintain applicable knowledge of CPR, Rescue Breathing, First Aid, and all other emergency care and treatment at test ready levels.
- Works well with others staff members of the Parks and Recreation Department and the public they serve.
- Enjoys working with children.
- Applicant must pass a Urinalysis and Background Check.
